
DESCRIPTION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

CMU/MICA SCHOLARSHIP:

The CMU/MICA Scholarship is a two-year, tuition only scholarship offered to incoming undergraduate Freshmen Students who will be attending Central Michigan University. This scholarship is funded by Central Michigan University (CMU); the Michigan Creativity Association (MICA) selects the scholarship recipients.

To be eligible for this scholarship you must meet the following criteria:

1. You must be a Michigan high school senior with a cumulative GPA of **3.3** or higher.
2. You must have scored **22** or higher on the ACT.
3. You must have been accepted by CMU by February 15, 2009.
4. You must be or have been a member of a Michigan Creativity Association (MICA) Destination ImagiNation team
5. Renewal:

To qualify for the second year of the scholarship you must maintain a 3.25 cumulative grade point average and full time continuous enrollment (12 credit hours/semester) at CMU.

The deadline is **March 1, 2009**. All applications must be postmarked no later than March 1, 2009 to be eligible for consideration.

An official copy of your high school transcript, your letter of recommendation, a copy of your letter of acceptance to Central Michigan University, proof of your ACT score, and your essay answers must be included along with this scholarship application in order to be considered.

Confirmation of registration from CMU is due before issuance of scholarship monies.

If you are chosen to be the recipient of both this and the Honoring Betty Schmidt scholarship, you will not be awarded both scholarships. You will be given the opportunity to choose which scholarship you would like to receive.
