■ **REGISTRATION**

The Registration Area will be in the Commons . Teams may begin registering at 7:45 a.m. Each team will receive a packet with the program, school map, and team participation certificates. Our Appraiser Teams try to stay on schedule, so please plan to be at your competition site 20-30 min. prior to your performance time. There will be a “Check-In” table near the Registration area with extra copies of required forms if you have forgotten any of them.
