## Avoiding Interference

This workshop is an example of how to teach skills without giving that dreaded 'interference'.

## Take on the Challenge

Now, as you & your team work on your Challenge, remember the following:

To train: teach the skill. For instance, have a workshop on 'Paper Hat Making'. Talk about different paper selection; how to create several styles of hats; cutting, folding, and shaping techniques.

Have someone come in to teach the team ANYTHING in general that they want to learn. Do not teach them how to make a specific item that will be used in their production.



Consider some "field trips" to look at materials! Take your team to local home fix-it shops, and craft stores. Encourage the kids to think about unexpected ways to use items.
