Honoring Betty Schmidt Scholarship:

The Betty Schmidt Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship offered by the Michigan Creativity Association (MICA) to honor Betty Schmidt's dedication and support of creativity, problem solving, and teamwork. To be eligible for this scholarship you must meet the following requirements:

1. You must be a High School Senior with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
2. You must be or have been:
 - a member of a Michigan Creativity Association (MICA) team
 - or
 - a member of a Michigan Odyssey of the Mind (MIOMA) team before April, 1999.

The deadline is **March 1, 2007**. All applications must be postmarked no later than March 1, 2007 to be eligible for consideration.

If you are chosen to be the recipient of both this and the CMU-MICA scholarship, you will not be awarded both scholarships. You will be given the opportunity to choose which scholarship you would like to receive.
